

INFORMATION FOR CITY RESIDENTS

Large Item Pickup

Town & Country Sanitation will have two Large Item Pickup Days. This is your opportunity to dispose of items that are not part of your regular weekly household garbage.

Saturday, April 12th, 2025 & Saturday, October 11, 2025

*Please have your items on the curb by 6:00 AM

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

X Lumber / Construction materials

X Brush

X Appliances / Microwaves / Televisions

APPLIANCE DISPOSAL

Town & Country Sanitation will provide dumpsters at the Richland Center Landfill for appliance disposal. You can take appliances to the landfill during regular hours from April 12th - April 16th and October 11th - October 15th.

- No Charge For regular appliances during these dates.
- Fees Apply for microwaves, televisions, air conditioners, and computer equipment.
- Important Note: Large items should NOT be placed at the curb at any other time of the year unless a large item tag has been purchased from the Clerk's office. *Items placed on curb without tags may be subject to fines.

OTHER DISPOSAL OPTIONS

For disposal of large items outside of scheduled pickup days, you can take them to the Richland Center Landfill located on County AA. Please contact the landfill for fee information.

RICHLAND LANDFILL HOURS:

- Mondays & Wednesdays: 8:00 AM 1:00 PM
- Saturdays: 8:00 AM 12:00 PM

ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING:

December 1st through February 28th

Regardless of snow, alternate side street parking is in effect daily from midnight to 7 AM. Park on the odd side on odd days and the even side on even days..

Yard Waste and Leaf Pickup Guidelines

YARD WASTE

- √Acceptable items: leaves, branches/brush, and garden waste only.
- ✓Pickup occurs once a month from April to September; refer to the calendar for specific dates.
- ✓Yard waste must not be placed in plastic bags; use biodegradable bags or leave it in open containers.
- ✓Place yard waste on top of the curb (not in the gutter) by 7:00 AM on the Monday of collection week.
- ✓Only one collection trip will be made per neighborhood from Monday to Wednesday; if your area has been serviced, they will not return until the following month.

Additional Notes:

- If yard waste is in a container, it will be emptied into the truck, and the container will be left at the curb.
- If you miss the pickup, you can take your yard waste to the landfill's compost area at any time (see details below).

LEAF PICKUP

- ✓From mid-October to mid-November, the city will vacuum leaves daily from different sections of town.
- √The entire city will not be covered in one day; each section will be serviced multiple times, but not on the same day or week.
- ✓If the vacuum truck has already passed, it will return after completing other areas.

During Leaf Collection:

- Rake leaves into the gutter for vacuuming and ensure there are no sticks mixed in, as they can damage the equipment.
- Do not park on or directly in front of your leaves, as this will hinder vacuum access.

Note: Frozen leaves can clog and damage the vacuum.

ORGANIC/YARD WASTE RECYCLING SITE

- The city's organic/yard waste recycling site is located off County A, to the right of the road leading to the landfill (before the landfill gate).
- This site is accessible at any time for city residents to dispose of brush, leaves, grass clippings, and garden organic waste.
- Containers must be emptied and removed, unless using biodegradable bags.

Prohibited Items: No plastic bags, construction materials, concrete, rock, metal, or household waste is allowed in this area!
